HOW TO READ YOUR LAMSON™ MODEL NUMBER

1. SERIAL NUMBER – Through the late 1990's, the serial number would look something like this: 935724

The first 2 digits are the year of manufacture – this can be important, since changes in design were made over the years- If ordering parts, please provide this if you have it.


New models manufactured by Gardner Denver™ use a different SN# system.

2. THE MODEL NUMBER

The model number will look something like this

856-0-0-0-6-0-0 AD, or on older models, 856-0-6-0 AD

This breaks down in the following manner:



All models will not have all 7 styles of impellers.

National Turbine and HSI™ follow the same numbering system.

For Hoffman[™] model numbers (such as 76106) the 761 is the model, the 06 is the number of stages. This does not indicate the impeller types, so information on performance is critical in determining the proper impellers.
